GENERAL INFORMATION

Air Force School Jaipur is a co- educational Senior Secondary school affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The school is a welfare institution functioning under the aegis of Indian Air Force Educational and Cultural Society, Delhi. Primarily established in July 1980 with the objective of promoting quality education, fine arts and cultural values amongst the wards of retired and serving Air Force Personnel. Soon after the commencement of the school, it was felt that large number of civilians' children residing in the nearby area were deprived of their fundamental right of quality education, due to non-availability of good schools in the nearby vicinity. Persistent parental approach to the school authorities for securing their wards in the prestigious Air Force School made the school management committee to decide to accept their challenge for noble cause and school doors were laid open for the wards of civilians.

The school is located at the foothills of Aravali ranges, facing picturesque surroundings of Jal Mahal. The famous historical monument of Amer Palace is only 4 Km from its premises. The school, which started with only 19 students in a single classroom with one teacher way back in 1980, today stands as one of the forerunners amongst the elite educational institution not only of the city but also in the entire state of Rajasthan. This became possible due to candid efforts, clairvoyant vision and keen interest of the School Management Committee and the school staff.

Today, the school boasts of being a pioneer in the sphere of modern education with over 550 student and 30 well qualified teachers, in Science and Commerce streams. Well equipped with Science Laboratories and Sophisticated Computer Labs to develop the academic veracity of the students, the school also provides the best possible sports and recreation facilities and encourage extra-curricular activities with the aim of developing all round talents amongst the students. The school is a 'Model' with its sole goal to make each individual student of today, a perfect citizen of tomorrow.

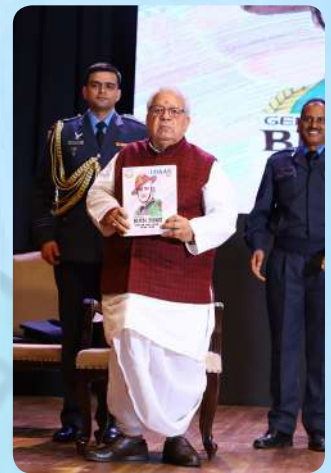

ELIGIBLE AGE FOR ADMISSION

A Child must be 6 years old as on 31st March in the academic year in which admission is sought for Class I. (Child born on 1st April should also be considered.)

- (a) The minimum and maximum age limit for admission in Air Force School, Jaipur in various classes is given below: (Child born on 1st April should also be considered.)

Note: The maximum age limit can be relaxed by two years in case of Differently abled children by the Principal.

- (b) There is no age restriction for admission to Class XI provided the student is seeking admission in the year of passing Class X examination. Similarly, there will be no upper & lower age limit for admission to class XII provided there has been no break in the continuous study of the student after passing class XI.

PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE FILLING THE FORM:

1. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Parents should be aware of AFS admission guidelines and shall abide by AFS rules and regulations.

1. If any parent submits wrong information, the application for admission of his / her ward will be rejected and if required legal action may be initiated against him / her.
2. Parent shall fulfill all the requisite details and present all relevant documents to support his / her statements.
3. Instructions for filling up the form and all other relevant information is available on the Air Force School website: www.airforceschooljaipur.edu.in

2. FOR ADMISSION IN CLASSES NURSERY TO VIII

Admission test shall not be conducted for admission to Class Nursery to VIII and the admission may be granted based on Priority category system (1 to 6 or 7 as the case may be). If applications are more than the number of available seats, lottery system will be followed in each category (Please refer Para E below for guidelines as admission priorities).

3. FOR ADMISSION IN CLASS IX

- (i) For admission in class IX, an admission test will be conducted and a merit list will be prepared for each category of priority separately. Admission will be granted in the sequence of priority categories in the order of merit.
- (ii) Knowledge of Hindi, English, Mathematics, Social Science and Science will be tested.
- (iii) The admission test will comprise of 01 paper for 1:30 Hours duration & 50 marks.
- (iv) Candidates must secure 33% marks in aggregate to qualify admission test. (Please refer Para 6 below for guidelines as admission priorities).

4. FOR ADMISSION IN CLASS XI (AS PER AFS GUIDELINES)

AFS Students: Admission in different streams viz Science and Commerce of Class XI in AFS will be based on Percentage (%) scored in class X examination as under:

- (i) Science Stream : A Minimum of 60% Marks.
- (ii) Commerce Stream : A Minimum of 50% Marks

Note: If seats remain vacant in class XI even after admitting the children of AF then the admissions to Non - Air Force children may be granted on the same criteria in the sequence of categories of priority.

However, there could be instances of lower enrolment in Class XI in AF School, especially those located in hard stations and remote areas after applying the above criteria for admission. In such an eventuality the Principal may send the proposal of lowering the eligibility criteria for various streams along with the details of registration, No. of eligible students, etc. to the Chairman, Air Force School, Jaipur. The Chairman, AF School may use her/his discretion in lowering the eligibility criteria to the extent as indicated below:-

- (i) Science Stream : A Minimum of 60%.
- (ii) Commerce Stream : A Minimum of 50%.

5. Instructions to fill the form:

DETAILS OF CHILD

- (i) **Name:** should be written in capital letters.
- (ii) **Gender:** Please select appropriate field Male/Female/Transgender.
- (iii) **Date of Birth:** Please enter as per birth certificate of your ward issued by competent authority. For admissions in class XI, please enter as per Class X Passing Certificate issued by board.
- (iv) **Age as on:** Kindly note that the minimum age for class I is 6 years as on 31 March, with a 2 year relaxation in upper age limit of CWSN candidates. Child born on 1st April will also be eligible for admission to Class I.
- (v) **Category:** Gen/SC/ST/OBC- Select appropriate field.
- (vi) Child with Special Need (CWSN): If it is applicable, then select appropriate field and fill required details.
- (vii) **Single Parent:** YES/NO: Select appropriate field.
- (viii) **Nationality:** As applicable.
- (ix) Occupation: Please select appropriate field: Govt-Regular / Govt - Contractual / Private /Others.
- (x) **Name of Organization:** Kindly write name of your organization where you are working along with other details.
- (xi) **Service Category:** Choose appropriate service category from priorities in admission as per AFS Admission Guidelines.

6. PRIORITIES IN ADMISSION

The following priorities shall be followed in granting admissions:-

Priority I.

Children of serving and deceased (whilst on active service)IAF Officers, Airmen and NCs(E).

Priority II.

- (i) Children of serving Air Force School staff (whose spouse is not a serving Air Force Officer, Airman or NC (E)).
- (ii) Children of serving Armed Forces personnel posted to MES at that Station.
- (iii) Children of serving DSC personnel posted to Air Force units.
- (iv) Children of serving civilian staff of Air Force units paid out of Defence Services Estimates.
- (v) Children of serving NPF employees.
- (vi) Children of serving civilian MES personnel.

Priority III.

- (i) Children of Air Force Officers, Airmen and NCs(E) who have superannuated from service and children of serving Army personnel.
- (ii) Children of Air Force Officers, Airmen and NCs(E) who have left service on Premature Separation from Service (PSS) or on completion of period of Regular Engagement(RE) before the age of superannuation.

Priority IV.

- (i) Biological/legal grand-children of serving and retired (both superannuated as well as those who have gone out on PSS/completion of RE) Air Force Officers, Airmen and NCs(E).
- (ii) Children of serving Army/Navy/Para Military Forces personnel, GREF and TA.

Priority V.

All other children, including children of foreign nationals/NRIs.

7. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION:-

- (a) For Admission Class Nursery to I : Date of Birth Certificate of your ward issued by competent authority i.e. Municipal Corporation or Village Panchayats. In case of Defence Personnel, POR extract duly signed by Unit Adjutant is also required.
- (b) For Admission Class II to IX & XI: Transfer Certificate of your ward issued by previous School and duly attested by the District Education Officer and Photocopy of Mark Statement of last exam passed.

8. WITHDRAWALS

The Principal may ask a parent to withdraw his/her ward at any time, without showing any reasons, if he/she feels that such a course of action is in the interest of the school.

Parents wishing to withdraw his/her ward should apply on the prescribed form by giving 15 days' notice. School leaving certificate, examination progress card and entitled certificate will not be issued unless all the dues of the school are cleared.
