Daily Activity Based:

My Day in Pictures: Encourage the child to draw or have you help them take pictures of their daily activities (waking up, eating breakfast, playing, reading, helping with a small chore, etc.). They can then arrange these in sequence and narrate their day to you. This helps with sequencing and storytelling



Jaipur Scavenger Hunt (Indoor/Outdoor): Create a simple list of things to find around the house or in a safe outdoor space (like a specific type of leaf, a red object, something round, etc.). Parents can guide them. This encourages observation skills.

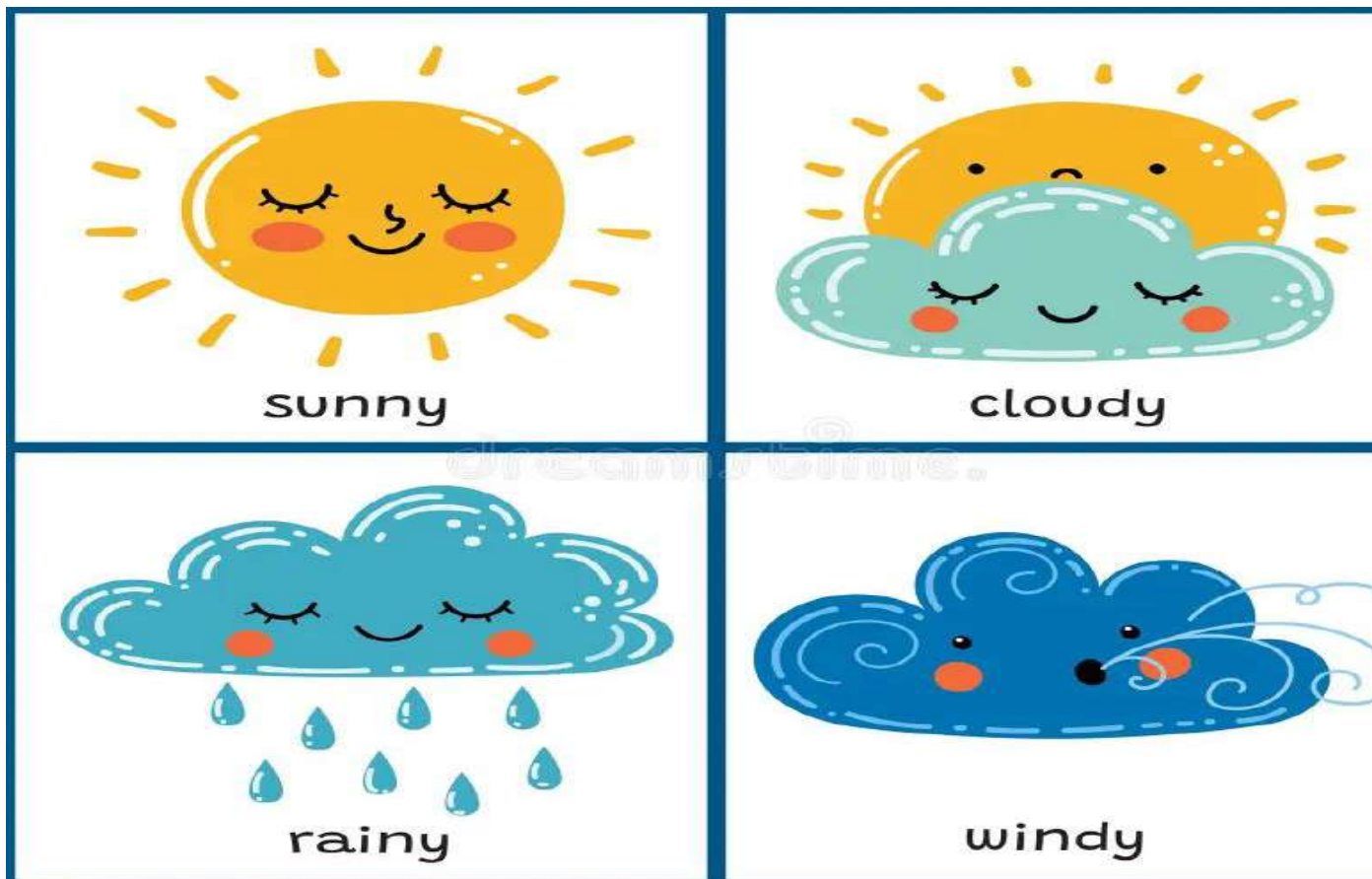

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Counting Our Blessings: Before bedtime, talk about the things they are grateful for that day. They can draw one of these things. This fosters gratitude and reflection.



Weather Watchers: Each day, observe the weather together. They can draw the sun, clouds, rain, etc., and you can write the name of the weather. This builds awareness of their environment.



Kitchen Helpers: Involve them in simple kitchen tasks like washing fruits, setting the table (with guidance), or stirring ingredients (under supervision). Talk about the names of the food items and the process.



Story Time Retell: Ask parent s or grandparents to tell the story and retell that story in classroom after vacation



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Nature Walk and Collect: Go for a short walk in a garden or park (even your balcony). Collect interesting natural items like leaves, pebbles, or twigs. Later, they can use these for a creative activity.
