Under the guidance of Mrs. Neeta Rastogi, HOD Science, senior students taught junior students various science concepts. This initiative promoted:

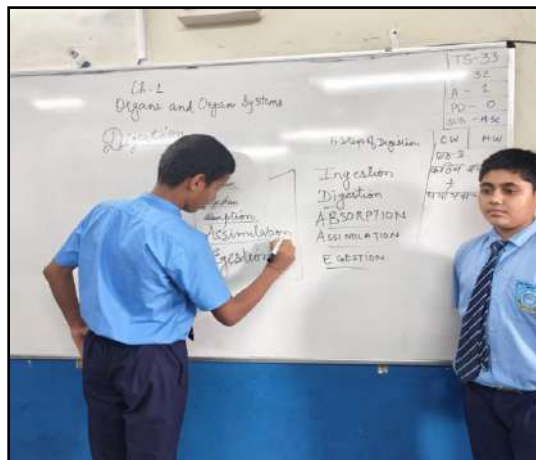
Key Highlights:

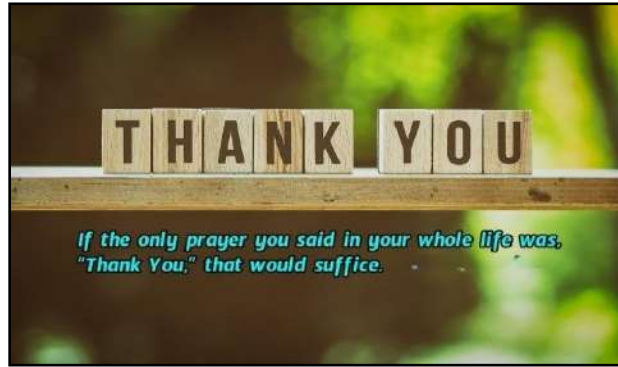
Rising Leader Summit Report
