Air Force Station Jaipur celebrated Road Safety Week with great enthusiasm!

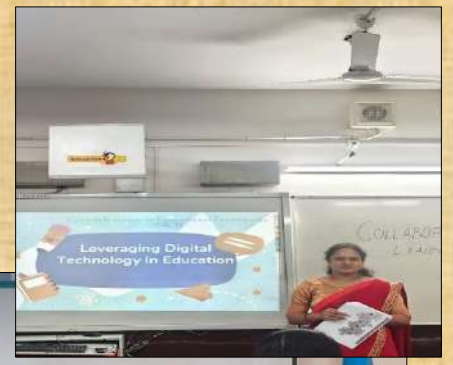
